While the COP21 gets together representatives from more than 150 countries in Paris (France), Eau et Vie is taking part of the achievement of those objectives by the implementation of actions which improve the daily of families living in the slums, first victims of the climate changes.

In less than 6 years, thanks to your supports, Eau et Vie:

- ⇒ Permits to 18,000 persons to have access to drinking water at home,
- ⇒ Proposes an innovating service of solid waste management in Bangladesh,
- ⇒ Builds a new type of sanitary in the Philippines.

AN INNOVATING SERVICE OF SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

People from Bhashantek (Bangladesh) have a new service: the domestic solid waste management! Following the signature of a partnership between Eau et Vie, Swisscontact and the Dhaka City Corporation, the project started. More than 200 people came to the official opening ceremony of the project on the 14th of March. This big change in a slum of Dhaka has been relayed in many local newspapers. In advance of the project, some awareness sessions have been organised in the area on the solid waste management and on the environment. The main objective is that all sewers are not choked up by waste. Today, 477 families take the habit of throwing away their waste in the bin, to facilitate the work of Amzad, the waste collector of the slum.







PUBLIC TOILETS MAKE A CHANGE IN PEOPLE'S LIFE

Following the request of the population, Eau et Vie has been thinking about a public toilet model. In Pugad Ibon (Philippines), the old sanitary were abandoned, dwellers had to go out to defecate. Linked with local authorities, engaged on the maintenance, a sanitary complex with toilets and a hand-washing zone opened in August. After the evaluation, the pilot project will be extended to other districts.









A STARTING PROJECT IN IVORY COAST

Following the prospection showing the needs in water and sanitary sewers in vulnerable areas of the Ivory Coast, Eau et Vie hired a program manager, based in Abidjan, at the beginning of 2015. At the end of November, the area of intervention, where

8,000 people live, has been identified and the negotiations with local authorities are almost ended. It will permit to start the building of the water system at the beginning of 2016.

TESTIMONY OF FATEMA, **BANGLADESH**



"Often, we were informed in the morning of the lack of water. In those days, I had to go to another pump far away. The lack of water was a real problem.

Sometimes, the water was not available for a short time and I had to go to get it early in the morning. I had to wait for hours because families were using the same source.

Now, at anytime we can use water! I don't have any problem to have access to water. It's also the same situation for other dwellers from the area. We have pure and running water."

Eau et Vie starts a project at Tacloban, in rehousing's areas where families touched by the typhoon of November 2013 live.

VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS IN EACH SLUM

In collaboration with local firefighters of each country and French firefighters, Eau et Vie trained and equipped 262 volunteers firefighters.

For the Olympic Games of Fire, competition between districts organised in March by the city of Cebu (Philippines), the voluntary brigade from Tipolo make the dwellers proud, by finishing 3rd!



In Bangladesh, Eau et Vie created a fireproof kimono for volunteers firefighters from Bhashantek, that can be put on the sari, very inflammable.
